

RACQUET DRESS CODE

- No Player (Member or Guest) will be permitted on the courts unless proper tennis or racquet attire is worn.
- Members, guests, and children should always wear proper tennis and racquet attire and shoes when entering and using the racquet courts.
- All clothing must be tennis and racquet attire by design.
- Acceptable hats and visors should only be worn in the traditional manner, bill forward.
- Running shoes, golf shoes, dark soled shoes, and other non-court shoes are not allowed for those over the age of 10.
- Denim, short shorts/skirts, cutoffs, cargo shorts, basketball shorts, tank tops (men only) cropped tops, sports bras (without a shirt), and bathing suits are specifically not allowed on the tennis courts.
- Club Management is responsible for monitoring the tennis and racquet dress code. In case of a dispute, The Sports Committee, the Club Manager, and the Head Pro reserve the right to determine what is proper attire.
- The Club Manager has the authority to render a final decision regarding the administration of all regulations regarding court reservations, court attire, and general court use.
- Tennis attire is permitted in the Clubhouse before 5PM, and at all times in the ASV and on the Pool deck.
- Please use good judgment when dressing for tennis and racquet activities. If you plan on socializing or dining in the Clubhouse, please bring an appropriate change of clothes that adheres to the Clubhouse Dress Code.

RACQUET GUEST POLICY

- All members and their guests are required to check in at the tennis desk when using the courts.
- Guests are limited to 6 times per person per calendar year and must be accompanied by the member.
- Guest fees and family guest fees will be charged to the host Member account at \$10.00 per person per visit.
